### **First 100 Days of the Biden Presidency**

- 1) Implement the basic public health measures needed to suppress Covid-19. These include: nationwide rapid testing, contact-tracing, safe isolation of infected individuals at home or in public facilities, regulations on use of face masks, and support for safe workplaces
- 2) Fund city & state governments and extended unemployment benefits, and coverage of Covid-19-related healthcare costs
- 3) Immediately rejoin the World Health Organization, the Paris Climate Agreement, UNESCO, the Human Rights Council, and join the International Criminal Court and the UN Convention on Biological Diversity
- 4) Immediately end the U.S. economic and financial sanctions on the civilian populations of Venezuela, Iran, and North Korea.
- 5) Immediately call on China for a mutual and immediate end of Trump tariffs and China's retaliatory tariffs.
- 6) Introduce legislation to restrict the use of "emergency" decree or executive order by any president, requiring (at the least) an affirmative vote by both houses of Congress within 30 days following any emergency decree.
- 7) Enact comprehensive voting-rights reform, to enable automatic voter registration, same-day voter registration, ending lifetime felony disenfranchisement, election day as a federal holiday, early voting required of all states
- 8) Introduce legislation to achieve by mid-century or early Net-Zero Greenhouse Gas Emissions
- 9) Create a zero-carbon jobs programs including: energy retrofitting of buildings, solar-panel installations, and electric vehicle charging stations along federal highways and other facilities
- 10) Re-start nuclear arms negotiations, including an extension of New Start, a freeze on the modernization of the nuclear arsenal pending bilateral and multilateral negotiations
